



SSCS FAMILY SERVICE AGREEMENT

Serving Together To Strengthen Our School Community

Purpose:

We are excited to roll out this program that we believe is vital to the success of Saint Simons Christian School. Family service hours will strengthen the SSCS community, help with the school's operating costs, and support day-to-day operations.

How It Works:

- The Family Service Agreement calendar year runs May 1 through April 30 each school year. Hours do not carry over from year to year.
If hours are not fulfilled, families will be billed on the May statement.
- 15 hours of service are required per family. This can be completed by parents, guardians or grandparents.
- We understand that not all families can meet the 15 service hours. In lieu of service, a family may choose to pay a Family Service Fee of \$150.
- Each family must declare their intentions to either provide service or pay the fee at the time of re-enrollment/enrollment.
- Opportunities to serve will be made available by the school. It is the parents' responsibility to seek out these opportunities to fulfill their service hours.
- A log for recording service hours will be maintained in the school office. It is the responsibility of the family member to record the hours. We will rely on the honor system with our families.
- A family member who serves on the School Board, as a PTA officer, or as an event committee member (such as Under the Oaks or the spring dinner & auction) will have fulfilled the entire 15 hours of service.
- Service outside of school hours for school activities (i.e. field trips) will count toward the 15 hours.
- Partial buyout will be allowed at the rate of \$10/hr. (i.e. – 12 hrs served; 3 hrs. remain = \$30 fee)
- Service hours cannot be transferred to another family.

Points of Interest:

- Studies show that when parents are involved in their child's school, students have higher grades and test scores, better school attendance, and better overall behavior.
- Parents who volunteer are more informed of events at school.
- Students will view school and home as interconnected if they see their parents volunteer on campus.

All families with students in K4-8th grades are REQUIRED to fulfill 15 service hours during the school year or pay a Family Service Fee.
